A Bit of History

In 2006, a small group of women came together to discuss the idea of creating a Women's Giving Circle in the Eau Claire community. They wanted to establish a collaborative effort in which members could work together, gather contributions, educate members about the power of collective philanthropy, and provide opportunities for involvement in awarding grants and making social investments that address the needs of women and children. With this mission in mind, the Women's Giving Circle, a fund of the Eau Claire Community Foundation was formed. In 2007, the WGC had 110 members and were able to provide grants to 4 local organizations for a total of \$10,000.
